Shah Abdul Latif University is located in the heartland of Upper Sindh, i.e., Khairpur, a former state that joined Pakistan in 1955. The main campus is located near National Highway and is connected by air, railway and bus services. The Sukkur Airport is one of the busiest airports of Upper Sindh, is on half an hour drive and Khairpur Railway Station is 5 Kilometers away from the main campus.

The beauty of the Shah Abdul Latif University lies in the fact that it is surrounded by famous archaeological sites; Moen-jo-Daro, Kot Diji Fort, Rohri Hills, Nara Desert, religious shrines Sadhu-Bella, Shrine of Sachal Sarmast, barrages and bridges (Lloyds Barrage) and vibrant culture where people of the area are very friendly and hospitable.

The present campus of the University covers an area of 291 acres of land is on just three kilometers from Khairpur town. Background and Goals:

The Islamic Countries Society of Statistical Sciences (ISOSS) is holding the 15th International Conference on Statistical Sciences devoted to all aspects of Statistical Technology and Quality Management, Public Health, Management Sciences and Law, Pharmaceutical, Environmental and Demographic Sciences.

The theme of the Conference is to *highlight advances in statistics, economic growth, challenges and development* through GIS and other information technology tools. The Conference will focus on theoretical and empirical aspects of the official statistics in modern technology.

It also aims to stimulate a comparative analysis of the role of the computer technology in conducting surveys and survey designs in Pakistan and Islamic Countries. Instructions to Authors of Contributed Papers

All Authors of invited and contributed papers are requested to follow the instructions:

1. Manuscripts should be type-written, single-spaced size 5" x 7.5" (width x height) with "Time New Roman" Font size 10. The paper should be divided into sections, numbered by Arabic numerals and with suitable short verbal titles. Pages should be numbered at the bottom. Running titles should also be given.
2. The name, full postal address and Email address of each author should be given immediately below the title of the paper.
3. Equations should be centered, with identifying numbers in parentheses.
4. Tables should be inserted in the text as close to the point of reference as possible.
5. References should be indicated in the text by author's name(s) and the year of publication in parentheses. All references should also be given alphabetically at the end of the paper.

Please note that contributed papers should not be more than SIX pages.
